I had to [A]leave a little girl in [D]Kingston town.*

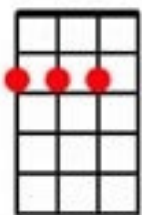
[D]Sounds of laughter [G]everywhere

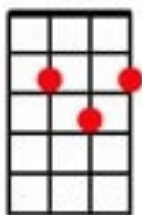
[D]Down at the market, [G]you can hear

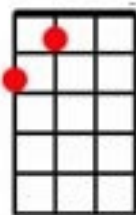
